




# Kaohsiung is a city with a beautiful harbor, and Cijin acts like a natural breakwater, protecting the Port of Kaohsiung. You can take a ferry from Gushan Ferry Terminal to Cijin, and enjoy the views of the City and the Port. The diverse and rich cultural landscape makes Cijin a constantly popular tourist attraction. Walking towards the sea, you'll pass the Cijin Star Tunnel, and find the "Cijin Shell Museum" nearby. In addition, Cijin preserves the three-wheelers popular in the 1950s. Tourists can take a nostalgic journey on these three-wheelers.

## © Cijin Beach

The Cijin Beach is as famous as Sizihwan. The Beach boasts find and soft sand, clear seawater, and many marine life art sculptures on the lawn. During the open period from April to October every year, there are many surfers and parasailing players gathering here to experience the excitement that only the seaside can offer.

There is also a striking nighttime view in Cijin. A plank road built along the beach is lit up with blue lights when evening arrives. It is embellished with LED light bars and ambient lighting. People can catch a glimpse of the romance of Blue Tears in Kaohsiung's Cijin Beach without travelling as far as Matsu.

## © Cijin Shell Museum

It is the largest public shell museum in Taiwan, displaying approximately 2,000 types of shell specimens. The collections are provided by Mr. Huang Ge-liang and Ms. Shen Shu-hui. The treasure of the museum is the huge "bivalve," and other rare shells such as nautilus, tiger cowrie, and Rumphius' slit shell are stunningly beautiful.

## The Sound of Sea — The Pearl

Near the Cijin Shell Museum, it was created by two artists from Taiwan and France. It is the largest shell installation art in Asia. Listen to the sound of the waves in the middle of the Pearl. The back and forth pounding is truly amazing.

### Rainbow Arch

Located next to the Cijin Seaside Park Visitor Center, the Rainbow Arch symbolizes the rainbow after the rain, which stays because of the beautiful coast of Cijin.



### © Cijin Star Tunnel The walls are painted with the theme of the ocean and starry sky. With various light and shadow changes, walking through it is like being in a mysterious and dreamy underwater world. The Star Tunnel connects unique scenic spots such as the Cihou Lighthouse, Cihou Fort, and coral reef. It is the only seaside bike plank road the country. Whether walking or cycling, the scenery along the way is refreshing.

## **©** Kaohsiung Lighthouse (Cihou Lighthouse)

Located at the top of Cihou Mountain in Cijin District, Kaohsiung, the lighthouse is the only one with a white eight-sided brick design in Taiwan. The lighthouse was built to ensure the safety of merchant ships and is a century old. Although it was subjected to gunfire during World War II, the lighthouse still stands proud and tall. Visitors can have a bird's eye view of Kaohsiung City from the top of the lighthouse.

Offering inexpensive seafood dishes, the simple-furnished restaurants simply wish to serve visitors with the most affordable and quality fresh seafood in an earnest manner.


