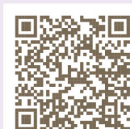

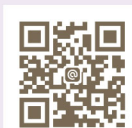

Gushan Dist.

Gushan District is home to many Western-style historical sites. Nangushan, also known as Hamasen, is a popular destination for tourists. You may start your tour at the Hamasen Railway Cultural Park, which houses Kaohsiung's first railway station, or visit Wude Hall to appreciate its beautiful architecture and enjoy the ocean view at the British Consulate at Takow. After passing through the campus of National Sun Yat-sen University, you will come to the beach and Xiziwan embankment, where you can enjoy a romantic sunset.

Hamasen Railway Culture Park

Formerly the Kaohsiung Port Station, it was Kaohsiung's first railway station and is the only century-old train station in Taiwan that can resume operations.

KW2

Yancheng Dist.

Yancheng District is full of exotic charm and adjacent to Love River and Kaohsiung Port, while boasting a magnificent night view. In the early days, the Xinle Street area was filled with jewelers' shops, earning it the nickname "Street of Gold." Charming, imported goods and nostalgic items can be found at the Kuchan Shopping Street! The Pier-2 Art Center is a trendy exhibition space converted from old warehouses, featuring numerous public art pieces. Visitors can also stroll or cycle along the riverside bike path of Love River, stopping by the attractions along the way and enjoying the laid-back atmosphere of Kaohsiung.

The Pier-2 Art Center

The Pier-2 Art Center, originally an abandoned warehouse site used by the port industry, has been made into a unique open art space and become Kaohsiung's most popular cultural spot.

Kaohsiung music center

As a base for southern Taiwan's music, the Center hosts pop music performances, nurtures domestic pop music talents and supports networking within the industry. Besides musical performances, the Center is also well integrated into the harbor scenery, making it the latest hot spot for travelers and a place for recreation.

The Great Harbor Bridge

Located in the 3rd wet basin of the Port of Kaohsiung, it is Asia's longest cross-port revolving bridge, and is able to make a horizontal rotation within 3 minutes. It is linked to Pier-2 Art Center, Kaohsiung Port Warehouses and Asia New Bay Area by the waterfront Kaohsiung light rail, forming a tourism corridor in Kaohsiung Harbor.

Shoushan Lovers' Viewing Platform

Located next to the Shoushan Martyrs' Shrine, the platform is adorned with 32 decorative plaques featuring declarations of love, symbolizing love as a universal language transcending borders. There is also a couples' art installation called "Love Megaphone" installed.

Wude Martial Arts Center

During the Japanese colonial period, the Japanese built the Wude Halls throughout Taiwan to promote the ethics of martial arts; these were the very places for police and young students to practice judo and kendo.

Yancheng Peace Memorial Park and 228 Memorial Monument

Located near Love River and the site of the 228 Incident, the 228 Peace Memorial Park is the perfect place for locals to engage in leisurely activities. The 228 Memorial Monument describes the details of the incident, hoping to comfort the hurt souls and serve as a warning to the future generations.

Yancheng Jyuejiang Shopping Area

It used to be a commercial district which sold imported goods in bulk. Over the years, it is no longer a place of fashion but has been given a new life. Today's Juejiang shopping area is a place to be cherished as it brings back memories and where one can hunt for things of the past. The Japanese-style streets are dotted with merchant stores and shops with cultural and creative products and filled with nostalgic taste from the olden days. Juejiang is a place where you can relax and enjoy some tranquility.

ALIEN Art Centre

The only military building surviving from the Cold War era in Taiwan, it has been repurposed into a contemporary art museum by ALIEN ART. Seasonal international art and design exhibitions are held throughout the year.

British Consulate at Takow

Built in 1879, it is the oldest existing Western-style modern architecture in Taiwan and the first consulate established by the British government in Taiwan. The consulate is located near the Shaochuantou Pier, while the consul's residence is built on a small hill.

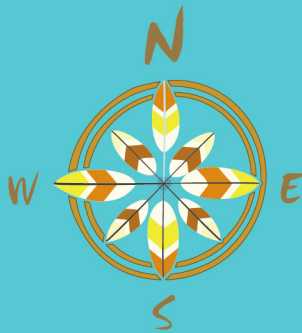
Kaohsiung Museum of History
