The exterior is of a Chinese architecture style, geographically, it is a "floating lotus" terrain, and the front of the emple shows the feng shui of fighting lobster harbor. The Song Jiang Arms Museum next to it is one of the key attractions.

Shunxian Temple

Neimen District, known throughout Taiwan for its "Zongpu Shi (master chef for catering)" and "Song Jiang Array," is named the "Hometown of Zongpu Shi." Almost one in five households

in the District make a living from "banquet catering," and there are also quite a few folk festi-

vals in the area. There is the Neimen Zizhu Temple in Neimen District, which enshrines the

Guanyin Buddha. The Temple is not only the center of belief for the locals, but also a

diamond-rated attraction. "Duck King Chu Yi-kuei Culture Park" and "Yanmen Yanyu (Misty


Rain at the Goose Gate)" both are on the list of "Neimen's Eight Sights."

Mucha Church & **Mucha Suspension Bridge**

Standing against the blue sky and rugged mountains, the Mucha Church was founded in 1868 and is the third oldest Presbyterian Church in Taiwan. Located near the Mucha Church, the Mucha Suspension Bridge looks like a silver thread spanning two mountain peaks, and is a special attraction along the Shicuo Hiking Trail.

Ouck King-Chu Yi-kuei Culture Park

hu Yi-kuei moved to Taiwan during the Qing dynasty. Chu was the leader of the largest anti-Manchu uprising in Taiwan. He called himself the king after he rallied in revolt against the Manchu authori-ties.



Seven stars


One of the Eight Sights, the "Seven stars" is located in the north of Guanting Village, Neimen District. A legend says that seven stars fell in Neimen in ancient times, becoming 7 mounds, named after their resemblance to the Big Dipper.

Yanmen Yanyu (Neimen's Eight Sights)

Located at the southwest of Neidong Village, Neimen District, the mountainous area looks like a flock of geese in flight as a result of the badlands formed by grey lime and grotesque peaks formed by wind and rain over many years. The dreamlike scene of this place has been one of Taiwan's 8 Scenic Sights since the Qing dynasty.

Named for its height of 308 meters above sea leave, Neimen 308 Highland is located where Zuozhen in Tainan and Longqi meet. It has the highest point in the nearby mountains.






Siaofenwei Eudemon Rose Garden
