



Huofang (often a three-sided courtyard house) is the most common architectural form of Hakka residences in Taiwan. The huofang buildings on Meinong's first street, Yong'an Old Street, and Bo' ai Street represent the epitome of Meinong's history. Along the Shizitou (Lion's Head) Canal, after crossing Shuiqiao (water bridge), visitors will be able to see the well-preserved huofang while taking a stroll on Bo' ai Street.

National Monument: **Zhuzaimen Power Plant**

The power plant was built under Japanese rule to provide power to southern Taiwan. It is a three-story brick building imitating the Baroque style and is Taiwan's first "industrial monument."
